Announcing a Poster Session focused on Marine Laboratories and Marine Field Stations

112th Annual Meeting of the National Shellfisheries Association Baltimore, Maryland

March 29 – April 2, 2020

Marine Laboratories and Field Stations play an important role in discovery, teaching, training, and outreach. The poster session will highlight the diversity of marine habitats and species, as well as research opportunities associated with these laboratories and field stations. The poster session will provide a venue to learn about facilities, equipment and opportunities available to visiting and other researchers, when researchers can visit, and opportunities for teaching summer or other classes, and opportunities for students. The posters do not have to focus on shellfish.

Posters should include: 1) Where the laboratory/field station is located; 2) Special opportunities and facilities/equipment available; 3) Dates when scientists and their students can visit and application deadlines; 4) Whether or not housing is available; 5) Photos that highlight the unique location and habitats; and, 6) One or more examples highlighting current work at the lab or field station.
